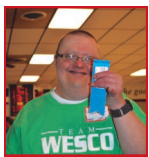
Fundraiser and Grant allow for a new mini bus

Be sure to mark your calendars for June 2013 for the fifth annual golf tournament. Exact date will be announced at a later date.



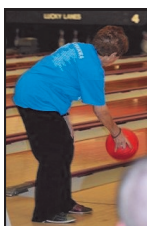
Several clients go on to Special Olympics Regional Bowling
